

# MENS BASKETBALL MEETING AGENDA

1. Welcome & Roll Call
  - \* Department policy (Fees, Players & Philosophy)
  - \* Purpose of this organizational meeting
2. Registration Information
  - \* Only teams with at least 5 players & sponsor fee paid by Friday October 21 5:00 p.m. will be guaranteed a spot in the league. **New players must be signed up the day before the game—NO EXCEPTIONS**
  - \* Players are not registered & on roster until fees are paid (including N/R Fee if applicable), residency is verified and current liability waiver is on file.
  - \* Non-resident fees ( \$100.00 team cap has been added)
    - ☞ if play on 2 Men's Basketball Teams, only pay NR fee one time
    - ☞ only those who physically reside in SF are exempt, no other exceptions.
    - ☞ Flat team fee next year?
3. Conduct, Sportsmanship, Technicals
  - \* Player Code of Conduct
  - \* Officials
4. Jerseys - we have accurate records of what your team has received the last 5 years.
  - \* If your team or individuals need jerseys call the Recreation Office (804-4600) and order them by **October 28**. This is your team Captains responsibility to get me the names and sizes!
  - \* Jerseys will be delivered to your 1<sup>st</sup> regular season game.
5. League Descriptions
  - "A" League - (THURSDAY)"Open League"
  - "B" League - (MONDAY)HS or college players over 30 years of age, younger players without high school experience. ( two leagues, upper and lower)
  - "C" League - (MONDAY)Recreational league, players over 25 years, HS or college players over 35 years of age. ( Young guys with no hops, and crossed eyes)
  - "D" League - (THURSDAY)ALL players must be at least 40 years of age before January 1, 2011.  
Thursday B/C - (THURSDAY) Recreational League; Players over 25 years; High School or College players over 30 years
6. Rules - Listed on back.
7. Facilities
  - \* Observe posted signs (do not bounce balls in halls, etc.)
  - \* Do not bring young children and leave unattended. We do not provide a babysitting service, and they cannot run around in the halls.
8. Nebo Tournament
  - \* Monday, February 27 through Thursday March 1, 2012.
  - \* Teams that struggle with rules, code of conduct or are caught cheating will not be included in the Nebo Tournament.
9. Practice Games
  - \* Only sign up for 1 practice game time each week.
  - \* Time slots should be shared by teams of same league. (Match up of age/ability)
  - \* Time slots may be reassigned by Rec. Dept. to fill holes in gym schedule.
  - \* There will be officials and scorekeepers provided for the second week only.
10. League play will begin November 7<sup>th</sup> for the Monday league and November 3<sup>rd</sup> for Thursday leagues.

**ATTENTION: Children must not be left unattended In the gym. Children will not be allowed to play or run back and forth In the hallways, foyers or balconies. If you are not going to tend your children, please leave them home!**

**SPECIAL RULES**

1. Games will consist of two 18 minute halves with a 3 minute break for half-time. A four minute warm-up time will be allowed before the start of the ball game. Clock runs straight through except for shooting fouls or if the ball is away from the action. Clock will stop during the last minute of each half on every whistle.
2. Two time-outs per team each half (no carry over). After all time outs, ball may taken out of bounds at half court.
3. Bonus shots: One and one will be shot beginning on the 7<sup>th</sup> team foul. Two shot penalty will be shot from the 10<sup>th</sup> team foul on.
4. No players added to your team roster without approval. No player may switch teams during the season. (Do not have friends come and play under assumed names.) No players may be added after January 27, 2012.
5. There will be no forfeit of games due to lack of players. Teams may play with less than five players. Officials will be expected to officiate even if there is less than five per team.
6. All games will be governed by High School Basketball rules unless otherwise stated. Remember that no player may enter the lane on a foul shot until the ball makes contact with the rim.
7. If a team is ahead by 15 points or more the with 2 minutes or less remaining in the game, the clock will not stop, **NOT EVEN FOR FOUL SHOTS!!!**



2011-2012 regular player fee is \$60.00 per player and \$200.00 sponsor fee per team. **PLAYERS MUST PAY BY THURSDAY, IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PLAY THE FOLLOWING WEEK.** This allows us time to get them on the roster. The only way to get on the roster is to pay their fee and have a Lifetime Liability Waiver on file. **IF AN INELIGIBLE PLAYER IS USED, THE GAME WILL BE FORFEITED.** No pay ... no play! Scorekeepers & Gym Supervisors are not allowed to accept fees. All fees must be paid in the Recreation Office. Office Hours: Monday - Fridays, 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The SPANISH FORK CITY COUNCIL has mandated that ALL PLAYERS that live outside Spanish Fork City Limits will be required to pay an additional \$20.00 NON-RESIDENT FEE.
