Urban Fishing is a joint venture between Spanish Fork Parks & Recreation and the Division of Wildlife Resources with a focus on educating youth ages 6 through 13 about fishing and aquatic resources.



Meets once a week for six weeks. Tuesday session begins on March 27th & Wednesday session begins on March 28th.



Classes last two hours with the first 30 minutes spent with an instructor learning different fishing techniques and habitat needs and the remaining hour and a half spent fishing with their instructor.



All classes held at Canyon View Park or Spanish Oaks Reservoir from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m.



An adult instructor will work with and supervise children in groups of five or six.



Instructor will strive to make the fishing experience enjoyable and informative.

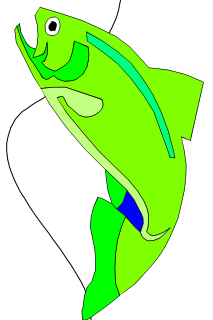
