**The projects displayed in GREEN are available in 2012.**

All other projects are RESERVED or not available until a future year.

**Canyon View Park (just off Powerhouse road next to golf course)**

- 1. Canyon View Park Stair Tower Painting and Railing Installation. Available April 2012. Warm/dry weather (March – October) project only.**
  - Install new railing on the concrete stairs
  - Replace broken and missing balusters

- Pressure wash to prepare for staining
  - Prepare and stain stair tower
2. **Canyon View Park Picnic Tables (24) Benches (9). Available March 2013. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
    - Replace any broken and missing boards
    - Prepare tables and benches to stain/paint by scraping off old material
    - Stain/Paint tables and benches
  3. **Canyon View Park, Park Gazebo. DONE May 2009. Available again March 2013. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
    - Prepare wooden benches for stain
    - Prepare steel structure framework for paint
    - Stain benches and paint structure
  4. **Canyon View Park Nature Restoration Clean up #1. Available March 2012.**
    - Remove fallen trees and debris from the south hillside from Stair Tower eastward to park entrance and on North side of entrance to parking area
    - Trim up overgrowth of shrubs
    - Pick up trash
    - Dispose of debris at compost facility
  5. **Canyon View Park Nature Restoration Clean up #2. Available March 2013.**
    - Remove fallen trees and debris from the south hillside from stair tower westward to Volleyball court
    - Remove fallen trees and debris from the and vegetation “island” east of the East Restroom.
    - Trim up overgrowth of shrubs
    - Pick up trash
    - Dispose of debris at compost facility
  6. **Canyon View Park Nature Restoration Clean up #3. Available March 2013.**
    - Remove fallen trees and debris from the south hillside from the Volleyball Court through Pavilion #2
    - Trim up overgrowth of shrubs
    - Pick up trash
    - Dispose of debris at compost facility
  7. **Canyon View Park Riverside Restoration Clean up #1. Available March 2013.**
    - Remove fallen trees and debris from along the river bank from the east river bend to the open field
    - Trim up overgrowth of shrubs and trees
    - Pick up trash
    - Dispose of debris at compost facility
  8. **Canyon View Park, Pond Restoration and Clean up. Available October, 2012.**
    - Remove the overgrown vegetation around the parameter of the Canyon View Park Pond down to the water’s edge.

## **RV Park (on Powerhouse road next to golf course)**

1. **RV Park Picnic Table and Post Painting. Available March 2013. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
  - Prepare and paint picnic tables and legs (13 tables). Repair tables if necessary

- Prepare and paint RV station posts (24 posts). Set them upright if necessary
  - Prepare and paint signs
  - Clean up trails leading to the Canyon View park below
  - Clean up trash on the hill side
- 2. RV Park Camping Area Restoration and Clean Up #1. Available March 2013**
- Work in area from parking curb, north to edge of hill – **Western-most one-third**
  - Clear weeds and excess soil build-up from parking area and along curb
  - Clear weeds and wild roses from oak brush groupings
  - Remove dead wood and prune dead stems from living trees
  - Remove topped stems down to the ground level (leave healthy trees)
  - Pick up trash from around parking area and down the hillside to the Canyon View Park
  - Clean up western most trail leading to the Canyon View Park below
  - Dispose of debris at compost facility
- 3. RV Park Camping Area Restoration and Clean Up #2. Available March 2013**
- Work in area from parking curb, north to edge of hill – **Center one-third**
  - Clear weeds and excess soil build-up from parking area and along curb
  - Clear weeds and wild roses from oak brush groupings
  - Remove dead wood and prune dead stems from living trees
  - Remove topped stems down to the ground level (leave healthy trees)
  - Pick up trash from around parking area and down the hillside to the Canyon View Park
  - Clean up center trail leading to the Canyon View Park below
  - Dispose of debris at compost facility
- 4. RV Park Camping Area Restoration and Clean Up #3. Available March 2013**
- Work in area from parking curb, north to edge of hill – **Eastern-most one-third**
  - Clear weeds and excess soil build-up from parking area and along curb
  - Clear weeds and wild roses from oak brush groupings
  - Remove dead wood and prune dead stems from living trees
  - Remove topped stems down to the ground level (leave healthy trees)
  - Pick up trash from around parking area and down the hillside to the Canyon View Park
  - Clean up trail to stair tower leading to the Canyon View Park below
  - Dispose of debris at compost facility
- 5. RV Park Restoration and Clean Up Along Powerhouse Road. Available again July 2012.**
- Work in area from parking curb, south to edge of Powerhouse Road – **From East entrance to West fence line.**
  - Clear weeds and excess soil build-up from parking area and along curb
  - Clear weeds and wild roses from oak brush groupings
  - Remove dead wood and prune dead stems from living trees
  - Remove topped stems down to the ground level (leave healthy trees)
  - Pick up trash from around parking area, along fence and over to Powerhouse Road
  - Dispose of debris at compost facility

## **Russell Swenson Baseball Complex (171 West and 300 South)**

- 1. Don's Field Bleachers. Available August 2012. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
- Repair foot boards and tighten loose bolts
  - Pressure wash old loose paint from bleachers

- Pressure wash foot boards
  - Paint bleachers
  - Paint bleacher support frames to the ground
  - Seal-stain foot boards
  - Paint retaining railings
- 2. Don's Field Score Booth. Available September, 2012. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
- Prepare score booth and concrete storage building for painting
  - Paint score booth and concrete storage building
  - Repair and paint inside of booth
- 3. Pony Field Bleachers. Available April 2012. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
- Repair foot boards and tighten loose bolts
  - Prepare and paint bleachers, foot boards and railings
- 4. REMOVED FROM THE LIST UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE Kiwanis Field Bleachers. DONE September 2009. Available again April 2011. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
- Prepare and paint bleachers and railings
  - Paint concrete dugouts and backstop foundation
  - Paint score booth and seal stain score table
  - Paint backstop
- 5. Fireman's Field Bleachers. Available September, 2012. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
- Repair foot boards and tighten loose bolts
  - Prepare and paint bleachers and railings
  - Pressure wash foot boards
  - Seal-stain foot boards
  - Paint score booth and replace floor boards and stain floor boards and score table
- 6. Rotary Field (Softball Field) Bleachers. Available September, 2012. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
- Repair foot boards and tighten loose bolts
  - Prepare and paint bleachers and railings
  - Pressure wash foot boards - Seal-stain foot boards
  - Prepare and Paint concrete base on backstop
- 7. Paint Snack Shack Exterior. Available June 2015. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
- Sand and scrape off old paint
  - Apply primer where necessary
  - Apply paint and clean up area
  - Protect brick and concrete from paint splatters
- 8. Paint Entrance Sign. Available August, 2012. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
- Sand and scrape off old paint
  - Apply primer where necessary
  - Apply paint and clean up area

- Protect brick and concrete from paint splatters

## **Fairgrounds Facility (475 South Main Street)**

- 1. Stall Barn Painting at the Fairgrounds. 12 Projects. 13 DONE October 2007–September 2008. Available again in 2011. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
  - Prepare and paint in one of the Stall Barns (Usually 30 panels)
- 2. Miscellaneous Painting around the Fairgrounds #1. Available March, 2012. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
  - Prepare and paint the 12 awning posts at the large indoor arena
  - Prepare and paint various fencing locations and moveable panels
  - Paint the fence posts and panels for the sorting pens
- 3. Miscellaneous Painting around the Fairgrounds #2. Available April, 2013. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
  - Prepare and paint the exterior railings around the tennis court building and the small indoor arena
  - Prepare and paint the railing on the canal bridge
  - Prepare and stain the canal bridge
  - Prepare and paint the railing around the flag pole area
  - Prepare and paint the concrete foundation on the High Chaparral Building and Shop Building
  - Paint the awning posts on the Indoor Tennis Court Building
- 4. Portable Fencing Panels Painting at the Fairgrounds #1. Available May, 2012. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
  - Prepare and paint miscellaneous portable fencing panels around the fairgrounds
- 5. Portable Fencing Panels Painting at the Fairgrounds #2. Available May, 2012. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
  - Prepare and paint miscellaneous portable fencing panels around the fairgrounds
- 6. Sorting Pen Painting at the Fairgrounds. 2 projects. Available May 2012. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
  - Prepare and paint fencing panels and posts at the sorting pens
- 7. ON HOLD. Steer Pen Painting at the Fairgrounds. DONE July 2009. Available again May 2012. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
  - Prepare and paint steer pen railings behind the outdoor arena.
- 8. Indoor Arena #3 Bucking Chute Painting #1. Available May 2013. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
  - Prepare and paint the bucking chute railings on the east end of the indoor arena #3.
- 9. Indoor Arena #3 Bucking Chute Painting #2. Available April 2013. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
  - Prepare and paint the bucking chute railings on the east end of the indoor arena #3.
- 10. Indoor Arena #3 Bucking Chute Painting #3. Available April 2013. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**

- Prepare and paint the bucking chute railings on the east end of the indoor arena #3.
- 11. Indoor Arena #1 Parameter Fencing Painting. Available March 2013. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
    - Prepare and paint parameter fencing and gates in the #1 indoor arena.
  - 12. Contestant Entrance Fencing Painting. Available May 2013. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
    - Prepare and paint the contestant entrance fencing and gates on the East parameter of the Fairgrounds property (off of River Bottoms Road).

## **City Cemetery (420 South 400 East)**

- 1. ON HOLD, Cemetery Fence Painting. 16 Projects, Available March 2012. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
  - Prepare and paint a 25 panel section of the wrought iron fence along 400 South or along Scenic Drive
- 2. ON HOLD, Cemetery Fence Painting #1. 1 Project. RESERVED May 2011, Available Again April 2014, Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
  - Prepare and paint the cemetery entrance gate at 400 east
  - Prepare and paint a 25 panel section of the wrought iron fence along the north end of the east parking lot
- 3. ON HOLD, Cemetery Fence Painting #2. 1 Project. DONE May 2009. Available Again April 2012, Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
  - Prepare and paint the cemetery east entrance gate (next to Centennial Park).
  - Prepare and paint a 25 panel section of the wrought iron fence along the south end of the east parking lot
- 4. Cemetery Headstone Photo Inventory. All updated headstones and new installations since 2005. RESERVED March, 2012**
  - Photograph the headstones in the cemetery to create a digital photograph inventory.
  - Add photos to an existing Excel spreadsheet.
  - Coordinate with the Spanish Fork City web site staff to merge the photos with the existing name and date database.

## **Miscellaneous Locations**

- 1. City Park Tables, Benches and Playground. Available March, 2013. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
  - Prepare and paint the benches in front of the library (5 benches)
  - Repair, prepare and paint the picnic tables on the city library park grounds
  - There are 11 wooden tables that need painting including the legs
  - There are 9 aluminum tables that need only the legs painted
  - Prepare and paint the large swing set
  - Prepare and paint the playground geodesic dome
- 2. Spanish Oaks Camp Ground. Available Summer of 2012. Warm/dry weather (April – October) project only.**
  - Clear weeds, grass and underbrush from around the camp sites

- Dispose of all debris in construction dumpster, provided by the city

## **Spanish Fork City Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project List** **Explanation**

### **Projects that received approval in the past are no longer receiving approval**

**Since 2009 it appears that the bar has been raised.** Many projects that have gained approval prior to 2010 have not received approval since then. A meeting held **June 22, 2010** with the Spanish Fork City Eagle Project Coordinator confirmed that the Black Hawk District Advancement Committee requires more exact adherence to the requirements set forth in the Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project Workbook for project approval.

**July, 2011: Recently scouts have reported to Bill Bushman that the Diamond Fork District Advancement Committee has not approved listed projects as presented but instead the scouts have been asked to add something to the selected project to “make it your own” or “leave a permanent addition” prior to committee approval.**

Spanish Fork City maintains a list of volunteer service projects that *seem* suitable as Eagle Scout Leadership Service Projects. The completion of these projects would help the city tremendously. These projects have been set aside for volunteer service.
