## **PRESS RELEASE *SPANISH FORK MAN CHARGED WITH THE MURDER OF KIPYLN DAVIS***

On Friday October 4th, 2007 Spanish Fork Police Officers and Federal Bureau of Investigations Agents arrested Christopher Neal Jeppson for the Murder of Kiplyn Davis. Jeppson is 30 years old and from Spanish Fork. He was located in the Salt Lake City area and taken into custody without incident.

The investigation into the disappearance and death of Kiplyn Davis has been on going for several years. Kiplyn Davis was last seen at the Spanish Fork High School on May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1995. Spanish Fork Police Officers, Agents from the Federal Bureau of Investigation, United States Attorney's Office, the Utah County Attorney's Office as well as many other agencies have been working leads on this case.

On September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2007 Chris Jeppson was found guilty of one count perjury before a Federal Grand Jury, and three counts of making false or fictitious statements to a Federal Agent, all which were related to questioning regarding Kiplyn Davis.

Jeppson is suspected in participating in the murder of Kiplyn Davis and the disposal of her body.

Currently one other individual has been charged with the Murder of Kiplyn Davis. Timmy Brent Olsen, age 30, of Spanish Fork. He too has been found guilty in the Federal Courts for lying concerning the Kiplyn Davis case. Olsen is currently serving 12½ years in the Federal Prison system.
