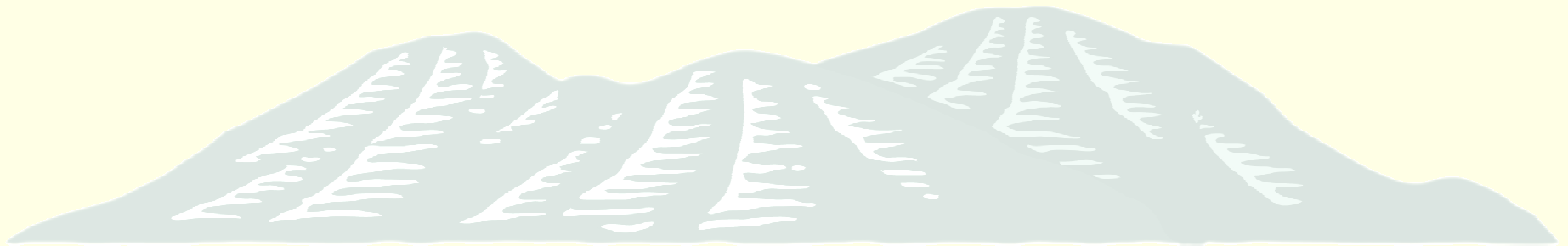

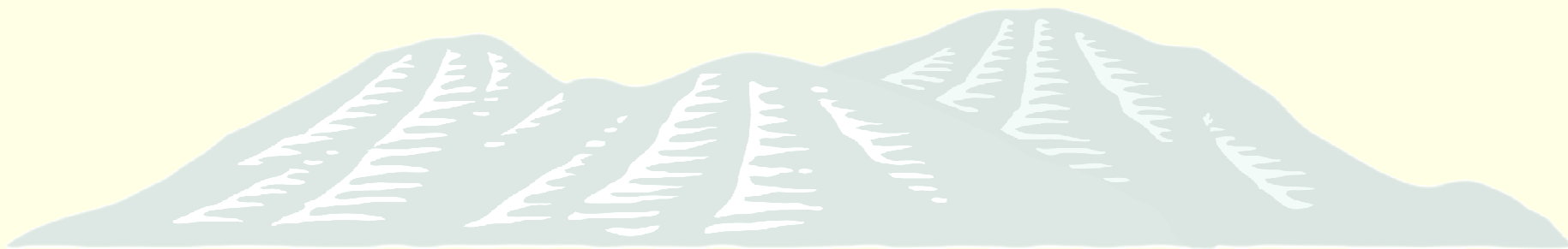

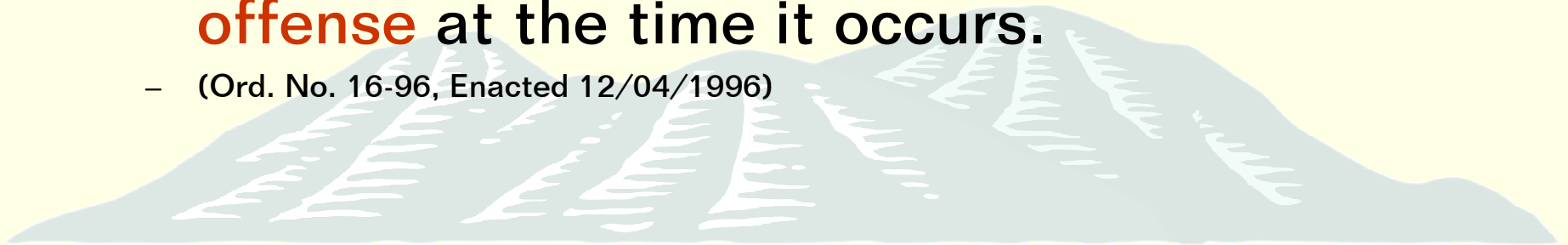


# Leash Law

## 6-08.030 - Dogs Running at Large

It shall be unlawful for any dog to be at large at any time within the corporate limits of the city. The owner or custodian of any dog which is at large shall be in violation of this section, regardless of the precautions taken to prevent the escape of the dog and regardless of lack of knowledge of the offense at the time it occurs.

- (Ord. No. 16-96, Enacted 12/04/1996)

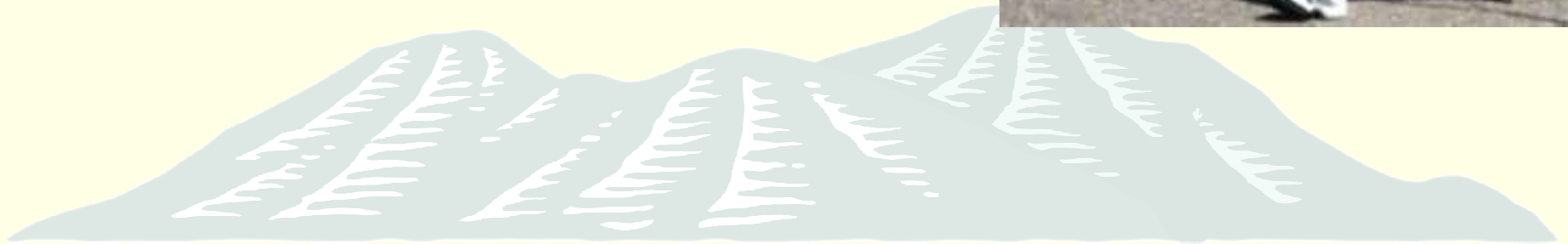




# A Little More About The Leash Law

# Impounded Dogs

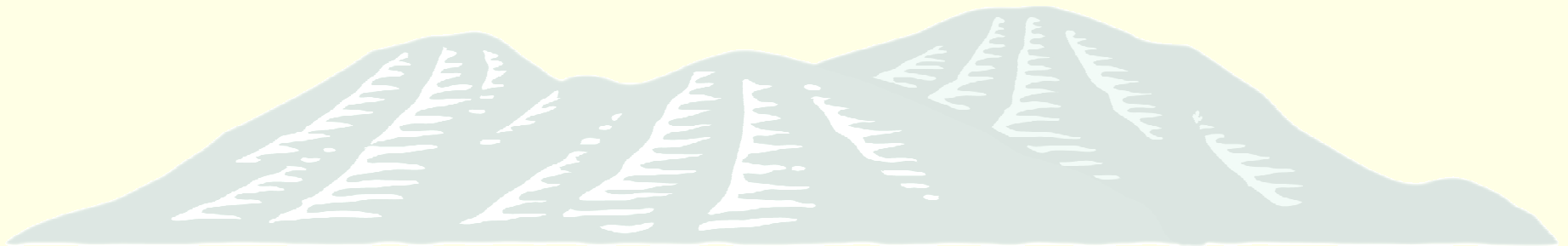
- Change this ordinance

## 6.08.180 Impound

A. Any dog impounded at an animal shelter shall be held up to five working days if it has a current year's license tag. After five working days, if the dog is not claimed, it shall be euthanized the shelter policy will be followed.

B. Any dog impounded at an animal shelter shall be held up to three working days if it has no current year's license tag. After three working days, if the dog is not claimed, it shall be euthanized the shelter policy will be followed.

C. Any dog voluntarily relinquished to the animal control officer or an animal shelter by the owner or custodian thereof for destruction or other disposition need not be kept for the minimum holding period. but shall be euthanized immediately The disposition of the dog will be handled as per the shelter policy.





# How Many Dogs May I Own?

## 6.08.170 Allowable Number of Dogs

- Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, no more than two (2) dogs which are three (3) months of age or older shall be kept at any residence or commercial establishment at any time. This provision shall not apply to licensed kennels, grooming parlors, or veterinary clinics. (Ord. No. 16-96, Enacted 12/04/1996)
- Exception: Kennel Permit (\$25 yearly fee)
  - Up to four (4) animals (dogs/cats)
  - Minimum of two (2) must be altered (spayed/neutered)

- **Held Twice Each Year**
  - March 5<sup>th</sup> 2011
  - August 27<sup>th</sup> 2011 10:00am to 12:00 noon
    - Held at the Spanish Fork Fire Department, under the direction of our Animal Control Officer, veterinarian and shelter.
  - Available at the Clinic
    - Rabies (required)
    - Licensing (required)
    - Distemper combo (optional)
    - Micro-chipping (optional and at a discounted rate/\$15)
  - Advertisizing
    - Fliers through elementary schools
    - City News Letter
    - City Utility Bill
    - City Web Site
    - Local Paper





# Dogs in the Parks

- 6.08.160 Dogs in Prohibited Areas
  - ..... it shall be unlawful for any person to allow any dog to enter in or be upon any public park or cemetery where it is posted that no dogs are allowed.....

(Ord. No. 16-96, Enacted 12/04/1996)

# Chicken Ordinance

- Permits Are Required (\$15)
- Yard requirements
  - Minimum of 5000sq ft
  - The coop shall meet the minimum setback requirements for accessory structures within the zoning district.
  - 25 foot set back from neighboring home
  - Coop Six (6) feet away from home
