

**SPANISH FORK CITY
REQUIREMENTS FOR BUILDING A SWIMMING POOL**

Permanent installed swimming Pools not completely enclosed within a building must maintain a minimum of six (6) feet to side or rear property line and be completely surrounded by a fence or wall with a height of at least six (6) feet. There shall be no openings in said fence or wall larger than thirty-six (36) square inches, except for gates, and such gates shall be equipped with self-closing and self-latching devices. If the building is used as part of the required barrier then it also needs to meet one of the following:

- A. All doors need to be protected by approved self-closing and latching devices.
- B. All doors need to be equipped with approved alarm systems when the door or screen is opened.
- C. Have an approved powered safety cover in compliance with ASTM F 1346.

Submittal requirements for a Building Permit for Swimming Pool

- 1. Site Plan 8 ½" x 11" in size to include the following:
 - A. Streets labeled, north arrow & scale
 - B. Location of pool in relationship to streets, property lines and existing buildings with exact measurements shown.
 - C. Height and location of fence or wall, include gates and description of material used.
 - D. Location of all electrical outlets and lighting.
 - E. If pool cover is used a copy of the listing showing that it complies with ASTM F 1346.
