Billboard Requirements		
1. Billboards are permitted: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Along I-15 from 3100 North to 1600 North and mile post number 259 to mile post number 258 (heading south) these billboards must be at least 500 feet from any other billboard on the same side of the interstate highway and located in an industrial zone. Along Highway 6 from mile post number 177 (Highway 89) to mile post number 178 (heading south) these bill boards must be at least 750 feet from any other billboard on the same side of the highway and located in an industrial zone. 2. Must be within 100 feet of I-15 or US Highway 6. 3. Must be at least 400 feet from any R-1, and R-3 residential districts. 4. Cannot exceed a height of fifty (50) feet, or twenty-five (25) feet above roadway grade level, whichever is less. 5. May be double-faced or back-to-back if the separation of panels does not exceed five (5) feet. 6. Each side may have a sign area not to exceed 675 square feet. 7. Footing and structure details must be furnished to the City Building Official prior to issuance of a building permit. 8. Must be a black monopole. 9. Utah Department of Transportation must approve the billboard location prior to City approval.
