❖ Glossy Ads (paperclips & staples OK)	❖ <b>STYROFOAM</b> (packing peanuts, etc)
❖ Telephone Books	
❖ Plastic Containers #1-7(see below)	❖ <b>FOOD AND LIQUIDS</b>
❖ Tin Cans (labels can be left on)	
❖ Aluminum Cans	❖ <b>GREEN WASTE</b> (tree limbs, grass, etc)
❖ Corrugated Cardboard	
❖ Cereal Boxes	❖ <b>DIRT or ROCKS</b>
❖ Tissue Boxes	
❖ Metal Hangers	❖ <b>LARGE APPLIANCES</b>
❖ Paper Towel/Toilet Paper Rolls	
❖ Junk Mail	❖ <b>PLASTICS</b> not labeled 1-7
❖ Small Appliances: example
