Earned Income Tax Credit Help

Do you qualify for free tax preparation? If you earned less than \$37,000 this past year and cannot prepare your own tax returns, you are eligible for assistance through a free tax preparation program known as Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA). In addition, you may also qualify for the Earned Income Tax Credit, which may increase tax refunds for qualifying individuals and families. To be eligible, you must:

- Have an earned income
- Be 25 to 65 years old without children and have less than \$13,750 in annual income
- Have a family with one child and an annual income less than \$33,030
- Have a family with two or more children with less than \$37,263 in annual income

VITA will help you prepare your taxes and let you know if you qualify for the Earned Income Tax Credit. For more information or to schedule an appointment with VITA, call the United Way help line at 211.
