FIREWORKS SAFETY IN THE CITY AND AROUND

The holidays on July 4 and July 24 bring out the fireworks. While these flame throwers are awesome to watch, they can be dangerous to people and to the dry landscape around Utah. As you purchase fireworks, Spanish Fork City reminds you of the local laws associated with discharging fireworks found in the Municipal Code §9.40.010:



1. The use of fireworks is prohibited in all of the Industrial 3 (I-3) zones;
2. The use of fireworks is prohibited in all areas south of the Spanish Fork River from the west end of the Spanish Oaks Golf Course, eastwardly to the city limits;
3. The use of fireworks is prohibited within 200 feet of any open field, unimproved lot with dry vegetation, or a lot with a vacant building and dry vegetative growth on the lot.

According to State law, fireworks can be discharged until 11 pm, except on the nights of the 4th and 24th, when they can be discharged until midnight. Remember to be smart and safe this year as you celebrate the holidays.

AN OUNCE OF HOME PREVENTION

As your home is perhaps the biggest investment you will ever make, performing routine maintenance couldn't be more important. AUDIT OF BROADBAND AND ELECTRIC UTILITIES

City employees will be knocking on your door in July and August to perform an audit of city services. The employee will not need to enter your home, but depending on the location of the utilities around your home, the employees may be required to go into your backyard. The purpose of the audit is to verify that every home is receiving the services they have requested and pay for each month.
